We sincerely thank our parents for their constant encouragement and support in every step of our journey.

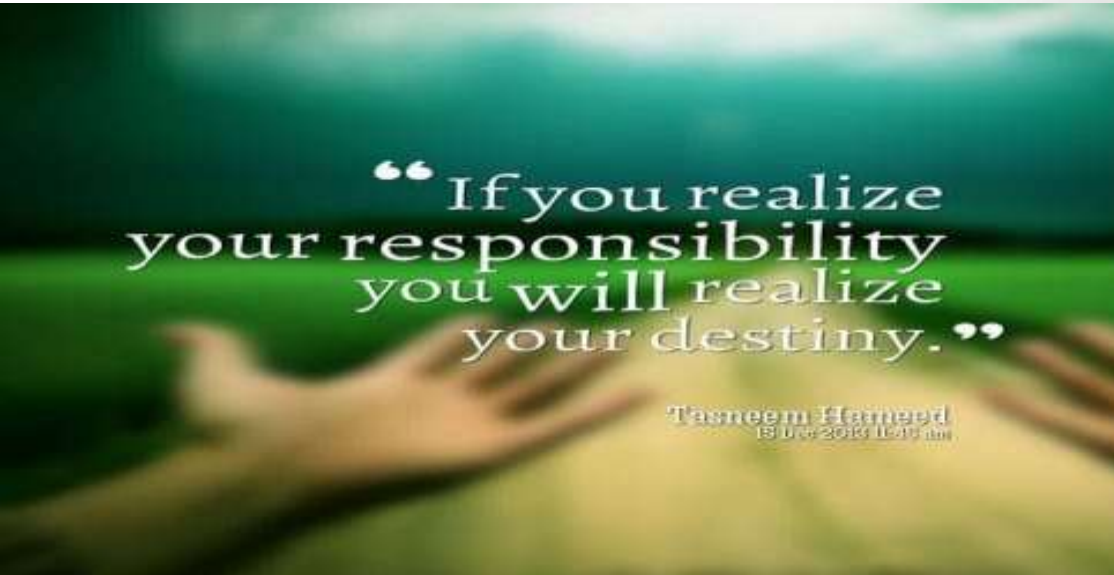
